We in GRN are thankful that we were able to play a small part in God's work around the world. We were not able to do all that we had hoped or planned (due to the pandemic) but as you read the following report I hope you will be able to rejoice with us in what God has enabled us to do.

GRN works in partnership with many individuals and ministries around the world. Indeed it is our hope and intention that our materials are used by many to share good news, plant churches and strengthen believers.

Stories from Around the World...

GRN works in over 40 countries around the world. Some of these locations are difficult places to share the Gospel, but God is at work in these places. We have received some encouraging news from our teams.

From Asian Country

A neglected language group is now receiving the Word of God in a language they understand. "... local sign language videos made and two churches for the deaf established."

Nigeria—Medical outreach

The annual medical outreach focused on three remote communities with people of different religious backgrounds. The team was made up of medical personal, counselors and cooks and ministered to many with medical, emotional and spiritual problems. More than 1000 Gospel CD's were given out, 735 patients received treatment and 150 people prayed to receive Christ.



From a ministry partner

Someone called our local leader and said, “there are 25 of us from this village, we recently received an SD card from you and we watched the video programs on it. We really like the story about Jesus so we want to accept Jesus. What do we need to do?” And they all accepted Jesus over the phone! Our local leader disciples them by phone.

From West Africa (Togo)

Our team went to a small rural village where a small Baptist church worships under a tree. The local people were trained in outreach using the GRN materials. Then they went out in small groups visiting house to house sharing the good news of Jesus Christ. Nineteen people confessed Christ. Our team went to another Baptist Church. Over 30 members were trained and 43 people confessed Christ in a door to door outreach.

Partnership is Essential

An essential part of the ministry is developing good relationships with church leaders and like minded ministries. GRN’s primary focus is the recording of Bible stories and messages for language groups all over the world. It is with the help of language helpers in translating the Bible stories into their language that enables GRN to make the recordings. Secondly, we are also dependant on churches and ministries to do the distribution.

In September, Walter was able to make arrangements for future recordings and distribution projects in Tanzania, through the help of the ministry leaders in the picture. This is a necessary partnership in order to see that the gospel is recorded and distributed.

GRN Australia & GRN Canada partners in reaching east Africa. GRN Kenya has been heavily dependant on the Canadian office for all of it’s needs. A new arrangement has been made with the Australia office to provide funding for the basic operational needs. The Canadian office will continue to support the recording and distribution ministry in East Africa, through the Kenya office. In addition, the Canadian office has also agreed to provide funding for other countries which Australia supports.
